

SCQG 2025 Festival of Trees Ornament  
The Little Ghost Quilt's Winter Surprise



**Supplies:**

- Scraps - Light blue, medium blue, and white
- 7" x 7" square white or blue for back
- 7" x 7" batting
- Any blue ribbon or string – we are not picky, but please provide your own. Cut this to 8" (or so)

**Cutting:**

- Cut 20 1 1/2" squares from a variety light blue, medium blue, and white scraps

**Sewing:**

1. Arrange and sew the 20 squares into a 4 x 5 grid – whites and blues willy nilly however looks good to you. Sew and press however you like. Throw caution to the wind! There are no rules! Are ghosts real? We don't know! We don't care about any of this! Just make a grid.



2. Sandwich ghost grid piece with batting and backing pieces. Tuck ribbon into the top of the sandwich and pin it into sandwich securely.



3. Cut out the ghost template and pin to the top of the sandwich. Sew on the line or just to the outside of it and remove paper.
4. Trim a scant 1/4" (or less, depending on your comfort level) from the stitching. When you reach where the hanging ribbon is you'll have to do it in layers so as not to cut off the ribbon.

5. Draw OVAL eyes in the general eye region, approximately  $\frac{3}{4}$ " tall by  $\frac{1}{4}$ " wide but a little bigger or smaller is fine. Definitely test your writing implement of choice for bleeding on some scrap fabric before committing. I had no issue with sharpie, but Renae did and used a micron pen. Even ball point might work. Aim for black, dark brown might work too.

6. Draw a thin mouth, preferably happy.
